POUCH WEIGHT BELT USER MANUAL

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Pouch Weight Belt is designed to provide a more comfortable and secure method of carrying diving weights around the waist. The wide belt construction increases contact area for improved comfort, while the rubberised inner lining helps reduce belt movement during use. Individual weight pouches help secure weights and reduce the risk of snagging.

1. PRODUCT FEATURES

- Wider profile for superior comfort
- Rubberised inner surface resists slipping
- High-grip stainless steel buckle for added security
- Fixed weight pouches reduce snagging risks
- Strong Velcro closures keep weight securely in place
- Removable mesh bags allow the use of lead shot
- Drain holes enable rapid water evacuation
- Available in M, L, XL sizes for use over drysuit
- Supports up to 2 - 3kg of lead shot per pocket or 1-2kg lead coated weight
- Ideal for recreational, technical and professional divers

2. CORRECT USE

Intended Use:

Designed for recreational, technical and professional divers, engineered to last in extreme marine environments.

Fitting:

Ensure the belt fits snugly around the waist above the drysuit to maintain comfort and ensure the belt does not shift during use.

3. CARE INSTRUCTIONS

After Use:

Rinse thoroughly with fresh water after exposure to salt-water, sand, or other contaminants, particularly in the Velcro and pockets.

Cleaning:

Hand wash with mild soap and cool water if necessary. Avoid harsh detergents. Do not machine wash or tumble dry.

Drying:

Air-dry in a shaded, well-ventilated area. Avoid direct sunlight, heaters, or other heat sources to prevent material degradation.

4. STORAGE

Short-Term Storage:

Ensure the belt and weights are completely dry before storing. Keep them in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

Long-Term Storage:

Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight, high temperatures and sharp objects.

5. MAINTENANCE

Buckle Care:

Ensure to check the buckle for any damage or wear before using this product, ensuring it can still fit around the waist snug and securely.

Inspection:

Before adding weights to the belt or starting your dive with the weights in their pockets, please check that the Velcro and pouches can close securely before proceeding.

Repairs:

For replacement parts, servicing information or additional product support, please contact our sales team at Northern Diver.

6. SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Diving equipment should only be used by trained personnel.
- Always confirm proper weight use before diving.
- Incorrect weighting may result in loss of buoyancy control.
- Never dive with damaged or worn equipment.
- Ensure the weight belt can be released quickly in an emergency.

7. WARRANTY

This belt is covered by a limited warranty against manufacturing defects. This does not include damage caused by improper use, neglect, or unauthorised repairs.

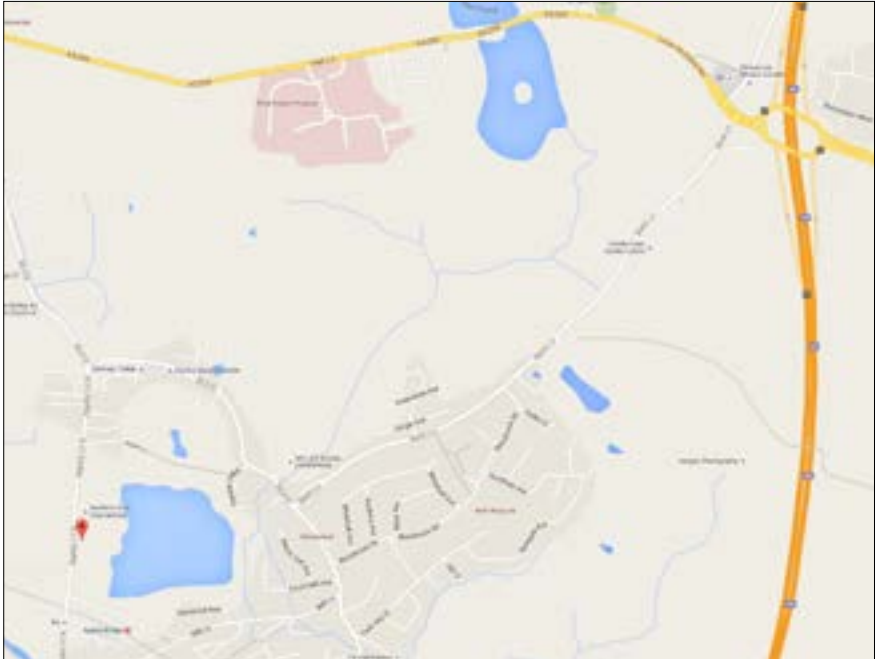
